

## NIH APPLICATIONS, PROPOSALS, AND PROGRESS REPORTS

**Reminder the NIH Public Access Policy (<http://publicaccess.nih.gov/>) is now mandatory.** As of May 25, 2008, **NIH applications, proposals, and progress reports** must include the PubMed Central reference number when citing a paper that falls under the policy and is authored or co-authored by the investigator, or arose from the investigator's NIH award. **This policy includes applications submitted to the NIH for the May 25, 2008 due date and subsequent due dates.** This is pertinent to the following sections of applications: **Bibliography and References Cited, Biographical Sketch** (B. Selected peer-reviewed publications or manuscripts in press) and to **Progress Reports** (E. Publications).

*When citing articles that fall under the Public Access Policy, were authored or co-authored by the applicant and arose from NIH support, provide the NIH Manuscript Submission reference number (e.g., NIHMS97531) or the Pubmed Central (PMC) reference number (e.g., PMID234567) for each article. If the PMID is not yet available because the Journal submits articles directly to PMC on behalf of their authors, indicate "PMC Journal – In Process" A list of these journals is posted at: [http://publicaccess.nih.gov/submit\\_process\\_journals.htm](http://publicaccess.nih.gov/submit_process_journals.htm). Citations that are not covered by the Public Access Policy, but are publicly available in a free, online format may include URLs or PMID numbers along with the full reference (note that copies of publicly available publications are not accepted as appendix material)*
